

Annual Regulations for IMO 2018

A.1 The Host City for the 59th International Mathematical Olympiad (IMO 2018) is Cluj-Napoca, Romania.

A.2 The Host Organization for IMO 2018 is the Ministry of Education of Romania in partnership with the Romanian Mathematical Society and the Cluj District School Department.

A.3 The Official Program for Leaders and Observers A begins on July 4th 2018 and ends on July 14th 2018. The shortlist problems will not be released before July 4th 2018.

A.4 The official arrival day for members of the IMOB is July 3rd 2018. Leaders and Observers A may arrive on July 3rd 2018 on payment for the extra day of 300 euros for a single room for each person.

A.5 The Official Program for Deputy Leaders, Contestants and Observers B and C begins on July 7th 2018 and ends on July 14th 2018.

A.6 The Contest days for IMO 2018 will be July 9th and July 10th. All Contestants must have been born on or after June 30th 1998.

A.7 Participation must be confirmed online no later than 15th of February 2018.

A.8 Registration of Leaders, Deputy Leaders, Observers and the number of Contestants must be completed online no later than April 20th 2018.

A.9 Registration of Contestants must be completed online no later than May 31st 2018.

A.10 Registration of travel details of Participants and Observers must be completed online no later than June 15th 2018.

A.11 The official arrival and departure site is Cluj-Napoca, Romania.

A.12 Accommodation is in shared rooms. Leaders and Deputy Leaders may apply for a single room. The deadline for receipt of such an application is April 20th 2018. Since extra accommodation is limited, full payment of the following charges must be made by May 20th 2018.

- A single room for a Leader: 600 euros
- A single room for a Deputy Leader: 400 euros

Applications received without the full payment of the charges will be rejected. No refunds will be given.

A.13 Applications for Observers to accompany the participants must be made by 10th of April 2018. Accommodation is in shared rooms. Observers may apply for

a single room. The deadline for receipt of such an application is 20th of April 2018. Since extra accommodation is limited, full payment of the following charges must be made in cleared funds by May 20th 2018:

- Observer A (accompanying the Leader): 2200 euros for a shared room; 2800 euros for a single room.
- Observer B (accompanying the Deputy Leader): 1900 euros for a shared room; 2300 euros for a single room.
- Observer C (accompanying the contestants): 1800 euros for a shared room; 2100 euros for a single room.

Applications received without the full payment of the charges will be rejected. No refunds will be given.

A.14 Consideration is given to applications from Observers wishing to attend and observe IMO 2018 for only part of the period of the Official Programme and in such cases, the charges, accommodation and all other relevant arrangements have to be negotiated with the organizers.

A.15 Proposals for problems must be received by 15th of March 2018. Proposals must be submitted via the portal at the IMO official website.

A.16 Countries that need the official invitation in paper form and send by usual mail, should point that before April 1st 2018.
